

TPSR Taxonomy

Level	Type	Criteria
1	Egocentric	Student focuses on themselves, is often off-task, and their behavior negatively affects others.
2	Respecting the Rights and Feelings of Others	Student exhibits respectable behavior towards others and has more self-control.
3	Effort and Cooperation	Student participates in tasks, has a positive attitude, and is self-motivated.
4	Self Direction	Student stays on task, is not easily distracted by others, resists peer pressure, and sets/adheres to goals.
5	Helping Others	Student displays positive social behaviors, is inclusive, and supports others.
6	Applying to Life	Student takes the learned concepts and skills and applies them in settings outside of class.
